Hello Quilter:

The Williamson-Pultneyville Historical Society is pleased to present the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Quilt Show at the Pultneyville Homecoming Weekend. **“The Captain’s and Sailor’s Quilt Show”** is scheduled to take place on **Saturday, July 20, 2019, from 9a.m.– 4 p.m.** at the Pultneyville Reformed Church in the historical hamlet of Pultneyville, NY. Anyone can submit a quilt to display, and we look forward to your participation in this quilt show!

We are pleased to welcome special guests to our Quilt Show. Specifically, Betty Means (from Webster NY) will be displaying a number of her exquisite and colorful quilts. Betty is a renowned quilting pioneer whom operated the first local Retail Quilting Store in the 1970’s. Also attending are Marti Tertinek and Alice Bills who will share historical “folklore” information on how quilts were connected to the “Underground Railway”. And lastly, we welcome Nancy Van Apeldoorn who is the Leader and founder of the “Lap Robes for Veterans”. Since its inception (in 2007), Lap Robes for Veterans have gifted over 9,000 lap robes to Veterans from every military branch.

**The following are the facts and requirements for participating in the Quilt Show:**

**FEES:** There are no fees.

**LOCATION:** Quilts will be displayed in the **Pultneville Reformed Church, 7784 Hamilton St., Williamson, NY.** It is located near the intersection of Route 21 and Lake Road - right in the heart of all the action!

**TYPES OF QUILTS:** We are **accepting large, medium and small quilts** on a first come – first serve basis. Since space is limited, we are accepting up to three (3) quilts per entry and/or will be at the Committee’s discretion. We also welcome heirloom quilts. Unfortunately, we cannot accept wall hangings, mini-quilts, clothing or other small quilted items. The quilts need not to be complete by the application date; only finished quilts will be shown. Please do not submit a quilt that was displayed in the 2018 Captain’s and Sailor’s Quilt Show (i.e., no repeat quilts). **The deadline for receipt of the attached Application is May 15, 2019.**

**PACKAGING:** Quilts should be placed in a **clear plastic bag** (do not use white garbage bags). Please provide the following information: name, address, phone number, and Quilt name. Place this information inside the bag with your quilt. For your information, clear plastic bags are available at most Dollar Stores and are labeled "Space Saving Storage Bags" by Stor-All with easy to carry handle (2/\$1.00 XL; 1/\$1.00 XXL).

**VIEWERS CHOICE:** We will be awarding local gift cards/certificates for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. These will be awarded by the Viewer's Vote.

**QUILT DROP OFF AND PICK UP:** You may drop off your quilt at the Pultneyville Reformed Church on **Friday, July 19, between the hours of 1:00-4:00 pm**. There is parking available across from the Church and you can enter at the main entrance or the north side door of the Church. You may retrieve your quilt at the Church at the end of the show between 4:15 pm – 5:00 pm.
