On Saturday, July 20th, 2019, Pultneyville will host its 62nd Annual Pultneyville Homecoming Celebration sponsored by the Williamson-Pultneyville Historical Society and you are invited! In addition to the Open-Air Marketplace from 9am to 4pm and traditional activities throughout the day, this year's events will include a Homecoming Parade, Car Show, Auction, Quilt Show ... and more.

We intend to have a bustling "Open-Air Marketplace" which will feature antiques and collectibles along with many vendors who specialize in vintage, vintage-inspired, repurposed and salvage items, as well as specialty food and beverage purveyors, jewelry vendors and other high-quality hand-crafted items.

Given the fact that the success of today's celebrations and festivals include a variety of activities which appeal to a broad audience, this year's festivities will also include food trucks, a history scavenger hunt, activities for children, horse drawn wagon rides, music, an auction and so much more. Please note that arriving early will help facilitate a smooth set-up for everyone as we are expecting more traffic than in previous years due to several new additions.

Contracts are due by April 20th as there will be a waiting list and limited space. Please return one signed copy of the attached contract along with your check made payable to the Williamson-Pultneyville Historical Society and mail to the address at the top of the Contract.
