Officers:

President-A meeting is scheduled with the Greater Rochester Area Community Foundation to discuss the GH situation looking for grant money. **Jackie** will go to this meeting on Friday Nov. 30th.

Financial Policies-Reviewed by Deb. Cheri/Sandy move we accept the proposed financial policy. Passed unanimously.
