- September 19 - 31st Annual Community Garage and Pie Sale

At this time the following are **PENDING**:

- Decisions regarding regularly scheduled MONTHLY PROGRAMS will be made on an individual basis and will be communicated by W-PHS Program Chair.
- W-PHS House Open-To-The-Public Dates and Hours are to be determined and will be announced at a later date.
- First Annual W-PHS GOLF TOURNAMENT scheduled for June 29th is pending and will be announced at a later date.

Feeling that it will be important to come together as a community in the aftermath of COVID-19, W-PHS may consider a modified event sometime over the summer for community residents, if and when circumstances permit.
